

SCHEDULE OF FEES

HUMAN RESEARCH ETHICS AND GOVERNANCE SUBMISSIONS

The Mater Health Services Human Research Ethics Committee and the Research Governance Office have established separate schedules of fees for HREC and Site-Specific Assessment submissions respectively.

- A tax invoice will be sent to you on receipt of your application.
- For commercially sponsored trials, please provide name and contact details of CRO or sponsor for invoicing.
- Please note that these fees are in line with other hospitals and universities in Brisbane.

Exemptions

- Under the following circumstances a partial or complete exemption will be granted:
 - Bona fide student's protocols as part of the requirements for a higher degree where ethical clearance is required.
 - Internally funded research by staff of Mater Health Services.
 - Protocols funded by such agencies as National Health and Medical Research Council and the J P Kelly Foundation.
- Requests for exemption must be addressed in your application (budget statement) to the Chief Financial Officer, Mater Health Services.
- Please provide details of exemption of fees in your HREC cover letter and/or SSA form (if applicable).
