

## Parking

Mater Health is committed to offering accessible car parking facilities for the convenience of our patients and visitors.

Mater owns and operates four multi-level car parks across the South Brisbane campus—detailed on the map on the reverse of this brochure. For your convenience, self-service pay stations are positioned at prominent locations in all four car parks (please note: pay stations are not indicated on the map).

The closest car park to Mater Private Hospital Brisbane is Mater Hill Car Park—indicated on the map with three entry points: Stanley Street, Allen Street and Water Street. Pedestrian walkway access to Mater Private Hospital Brisbane is via the link on Level 5.

Entry to Mater Hill Car Park is via automated boom gates that require drivers to press a green access button. A ticket will be generated allowing entry; please retain this ticket to pay for your parking.

Upon leaving the car park you will need to pay for your parking prior to exit as there is no cashier at the exit. This can be done at pay stations on the Mater campus using your ticket.

If you experience any difficulty when exiting the car park, please press the intercom button to speak to the car park attendant on duty.

## Frequently asked questions

**Do I need the correct change for the pay station?** No, coins (except 5 c and 50 c), notes and/or credit cards may be used.

**What do I do if the pay station cannot read my ticket?** Press the intercom at the pay station for assistance.

**What should I do if I lose my ticket?** You will need to report to the Car Parks Customer Service Centre, (Level 4, Mater Hill West Car Park or Level 1, Hancock Street Car Park) where your ticket will be replaced, and the maximum daily rate will be charged.

**Does Mater have disabled parking/access?** All Mater's multi-level car parks have clearly marked disabled parking bays near the lifts and walkways.

**Are there any drop-off zones?** Mater has several areas where patients and visitors can be dropped off. These zones are indicated on the map, but are subject to restrictions.

## Making your way by car

### Location

The main entrance for Mater Private Hospital Brisbane is located at: 301 Vulture Street, South Brisbane, Qld 4101.

There are also entrances via Mater Medical Centre, 293 Vulture Street, Mater Private Clinic, 550 Stanley Street and off the South East Busway. For your convenience pick up and drop off areas are located at all of these entrances—please refer to the map for these locations.

### Time

It is recommended that patients allow approximately one hour when travelling from Brookwater to Mater Private Hospital Brisbane by car to allow for parking and making your way to the correct location.

### Distance

The approximate distance to the hospital when travelling from Mater Health Centre Brookwater is 31 km—using the recommended main roads of the Centenary Motorway, Ipswich Motorway and Ipswich Road.

### Route

If this is your first time travelling to Mater Private Hospital Brisbane, we recommend that you familiarise yourself with the journey (as recommended by Google Maps). If you would prefer to view a detailed street map online, visit [maps.google.com](http://maps.google.com) and use the address supplied for Mater Private Hospital Brisbane.



## Mater Health Centre Brookwater to Mater Private Hospital Brisbane:

1. Departing Mater Health Centre Brookwater car park (Tournament Drive) turn left on to Augusta Parkway. 1 km
2. Take the ramp on to Centenary Highway. 1.8 km
3. Continue on to Centenary Motorway/M5. 5.7 km
4. Keep right at the fork and follow signs for Centenary Highway/M5/City/Northern suburbs. 350 m
5. Take a slight right on to Centenary Motorway/M5. 5.2 km
6. Take Ipswich Motorway exit to merge on to Ipswich Motorway/M7 towards City/Oxley. 7 km
7. Continue to Ipswich Road/A7. 6.1 km
8. Take a slight left on to Annerley Road/State Route 10. 1.5 km
9. Turn left on to Stanley Street and merge into the right-hand lane. 350 m
10. Perform a U shaped turn into Vulture Street. 450 m
11. Passing the Mater Medical Centre (200 m from the previous intersection), your destination is 25 m on the right marked Mater Private Hospital Brisbane, 301 Vulture Street, South Brisbane. 225 m
12. To park in the Mater Hill multi-level car park continue driving 260 m on Vulture Street and turn right on to Allen Street.
13. In 120 m turn right on to Water Street and in 130 m the destination will be on your left.
