- Processing instruments and equipment in accordance with infection control standards and guidelines;
- Adhering to sterilisation practices in accordance with current Australian Sterilisation Standard 4187;
- Participating in the continuous monitoring of service quality and compliance;

- Adhering to documentation requirements in accordance with Australian Standard and Mater guidelines;
- Operating equipment safely in accordance with manufacturer instructions, maintaining and updating performance records as required;
- Undertaking testing of equipment as required and promptly escalate any identified anomalies to the appropriate facility authority and/or resource.

- Qualifications in, or working towards, a Certificate III in Sterilisation Services. If you do not hold, or have commenced, such a qualification you must be prepared to undertake after commencing in the role;
