


Visiting Medical Officer (VMO) – Printing at Mater on BYOD using Windows 10 or 11



VMO's using a Bring Your Own Device (BYOD) will not be able to utilise the Follow Me Print secure printing available on Mater printers or to be able to swipe Mater ID/Bu access cards to print.
